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SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF EXPANDED USE OF ACT/SAT SCORES FOR PLACEMENT INTO

MATH COURSES & USE OF ARCHIVED ACCUPLACER SCORES

This document provides additional detail to the UHCC 4/23/20 memorandum (http://go.hawaii.edu/AUd) for English and Math placement.

ACT/SAT Scores

Expanded use of official and self-reported test scores for ACT Math, SAT Math (post-3/2016), and SAT Math (pre-3/2016) are authorized for placement into UHCC Math courses as shown in Table 1. Campuses should update placement rules accordingly in Banner.

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Archived Accuplacer Scores

Archived accuplacer scores (previously considered expired after two years) may be used for placement for Summer 2020, Fall 2020, and Spring 2021 registration. The future use of this measure will be reviewed in Summer 2021. How to best operationalize use of archived acculacer scores (such as building the rules into Banner or processing student placements through counselor overrides, etc.) will be a campus decision.

EdReady Placement Scores

Four EdReady Paths (one for English and three for Math) have been established for UHCC use. Cut-off scores and placement assignments are as listed in Table 2 for English and Table 3 for Math.

Campuses should update Banner prerequisite and STAR GPS Pre-College rules accordingly.

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EdReady Procedures for Students

- Students are advised to seek placement with multiple measures first (HS GPA, ACT/SAT/HiSET/SBAC/GED scores, prior course taking);
- Students should have applied to uhcc and received an 8-digit UH ID prior to setting up their EdReady Account;
- 1. Go to http://uhcc.edready.org/ to set up a student account;
- 2. Enter the Goal Key based on your prospective home campus:

- 3. Select the learning path (or paths) that are right for you. Counselors may help to advise of the appropriate Math path for you to take.
 - English Path 1: College English Placement: This learning path covers reading,
 grammar, and writing skills to prepare and place students into the most appropriate
 UHCC English course. Incoming UHCC students should complete this test to get a
 placement score to register for English courses and college courses requiring English
 readiness.

Please note which Math path students need to take to place them into certain classes.

- Math Path 1: Non-STEM/College Math Placement. This learning path is appropriate for all students in Non-STEM programs that do not require College Algebra or Calculus. This includes students pursuing Social Sciences, Arts & Humanities, Nursing, Education, and Career & Technical Education programs. This learning path covers math readiness for entry into Math 100: Survey of Mathematics, Math 111: Math for Elementary Teachers, and Math 115: Introduction to Statistics and Probability.
- Math Path 2: STEM/Algebra Placement. This learning path is appropriate for all students seeking placement into Math 103: College Algebra most typical for students in program areas of Science, Engineering, Mathematics, Business, and

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some Health Sciences (non-Nursing). Students attempting to place in Math courses beyond College Algebra including Pre-Calculus and Calculus may prefer to take Math Path 3.

- Math Path 3: STEM/Calculus Placement. This learning path is appropriate for all students in program areas of Science, Engineering, Mathematics, Business, and some Health Sciences seeking placement into Math courses beyond College Algebra including Math 135: Pre-Calculus: Elementary Functions, Math 140: Trigonometry and Analytic Geometry, Math 203: Calculus for Business and Social Sciences, and Math 241: Calculus I.
- 4. Take the diagnostic test for your selected path at uhcc.edready.org. You will receive an initial score that **begins** your study path.
- 5. Continue to improve your score by logging into your account and working on you study path until you achieve the required score.

EdReady Information for UHCC Staff

- Note: Students should have an 8-digit UH ID prior to setting up their EdReady Account;
- 1. Counselors, testing centers, and student services staff should direct students that do not meet placement with multiple measures to the uhcc URL: uhcc.edready.org.
- 2. UH staff to provide students with the campus Goal Key: ex. UH_HAW_Placement;
- 3. UH staff to advise students on appropriate (math) path/test to take.
- 4. VCAAs/VCSAs to submit a list (Name and Email) of campus contacts to be provided EdReady Administrator access. This will provide online access for staff to monitor EdReady scores and view reports of your students taking EdReady.
- 5. Qualifying scores from EdReady Reports need to be manually added into SOATEST to allow for student registration. This workflow will be accomplished at the UHCC system office for Fall 2020 but may also be done by campus staff given EdReady administrator access or with request for reports.
- 6. Note about EdReady Math tests. It is important for students to understand that EdReady is not a one-time test, but a learning path that students can work on, at their own pace, to improve their scores and level of preparation. It is noted that the maximum score for EdReady Math Tests (if the student gets all items correct) is a 75. Much of the content in the Math learning path is not included in the initial diagnostic and students can only improve their score beyond a 75 up to a maximum of 100 by working on the learning path. For the English path, however, students may score up to 100 after the initial diagnostic.
